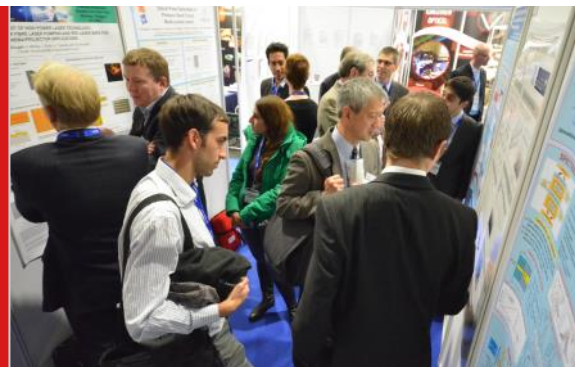

Posters that are accepted will be allocated a board in the main exhibition area where they can be viewed by all delegates attending the exhibition. You will be notified in advance of your poster board number.

Posters must not exceed A0 portrait size (1189mm high x 841mm wide). Pins or suitable adhesive tape will be provided on the day.

Posters may be displayed from 10.30am on the 9th and 10th October. Posters must be removed by 6.30pm on the 9th and 4pm on 10th October respectively, unless they are being displayed on both days.

Posters authors should be in attendance by their poster during the lunch break on the day(s) their poster is on display to answer any questions about their work from other delegates or the poster judges.

Posters will be judged on the basis of scientific content, effectiveness of communication and overall appearance and the prizes will be awarded in the main exhibition area (exact time will be confirmed as soon as possible).
